Nikon

I have previously used Canon for telescopic and macro photos, which capture small details, and Nokon for wide angle to get panoramic scene, both of which were used for the casino page, but have grown dissatisfied with the Canon - yesterday was cloudy and telephoto pictures were generally fuzzy - with low light the autofocus sets a somewhat long exposure, so photos were affected by camera shake; the past macro photos showed that focus was for a narrow range of distance so it is difficult to get the whole object, while flash tends to shine partially because of closeness with part of object casting shadow on rest; today I decided to try the Nikon with 200mm lense, which I almost never used after buying the Canon 300mm, for close photos - being telescopic, the focus works only if the object is about a metre away, but the magnification allows details to be captured despite the distance, and flash shines on the whole object.
